Recreation Committee Minutes

Jill Van Den Eng called the meeting to order at 6:33 pm. Jill Van Den Eng, Dorothy Frandy, Helen McCord, Tari Lust, Stacy Wolfe and Stacey Hardy were in attendance.

Lust made a motion to approve meeting minutes from August 4, 2011. Wolfe seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Frandy reported that the bounce house at the Labor Day celebration would be from 1 p.m. to whenever the person manning it wanted to stop. Mueller's volunteered to rent a bounce house for \$75. Recreation Committee would be responsible for transporting it. Frandy thinks she can use her truck for this.

Hardy, Frandy and Van Den Eng will be available Labor Day weekend and will man the bounce house from 1 p.m. until we decide to close. Jumpers will be charged \$1. All proceeds will go to the Recreation Committee special revenue fund.

Soda, candy bars and juice will be bought for the 2011/2012 season. Leftovers have expired.

Van Den Eng will make up new signs for concessions. Everything is 50 cents to make things easy. There will be only one size of popcorn bags.

Van Den Eng will make flyers for school and consider other advertising sources like Facebook and e-mail.

Zumbathon will take place on August 27. Four committee members signed up to help set up starting at 9:30 a.m. The Zumbathon already has 35 participants signed up. It is advertised with flyers throughout the village and in Oregon.

Information about fall exercise classes will be available at Zumbathon and the clerk's office. Fall Zumba classes will be in October and November on Thursday nights.

Community bike rides will not continue due to low turnout.

The Recreation Committee will not meet in September. The next meeting will be on Wednesday, October 5 at 6:30 to not interfere with fall exercise classes.

McCord made a motion to adjourn. Lust seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:16 p.m.
