Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Motion: Jessica Hawkey / Steve Lust to approve Aug 4, 2011 Safety Committee minutes, with Todd Klahn abstaining. Motion was carried

Motion: Todd Klahn / Steve Lust to approve Mar 3 and July 7th, 2011 Safety Committee minutes, with Jessica Hawkey abstaining. Motion was carried

Motion: Jessica Hawkey / Steve Lust to postpone approval of April 3, 2011 Safety Committee minutes to next month. Motion was carried unanimously

- 2011 Budget was reviewed and again appears overall expenses will be under budget
- 2012 Budget was discussed; very little has changed.
- The department work schedule was reviewed. There are some open shifts in September.
- Chief Barger's monthly activity report was reviewed and discussed. Received Certificate of support for Wisconsin Guard and Reserve Military personnel and a recognition plaque from WISDOT for "Click It or Ticket" traffic campaign.
- The daily activity grids for calls-for-service, traffic, MOC, NOPV were discussed. Due to a number of activities, a lot of time has been spent on follow-up and case preparation.
- Discussed the status of part-time patrol officer. Chief Barger stated Josh Cornell's training is going good.
- Personnel Evaluation Review is still being worked on.
- New Conceal Carry Law, as it relates to Village of Brooklyn facilities, was discussed. No recommendations have been made.
- Discussed possible action regarding change to winter parking rules, committee will not make any recommendations at this time.
- Discussed possibility of bringing a Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) access to the Village for residents to update license and registration. Committee agreed to recommend moving forward on this.
- Discussed recent Genesis Housing resident & management meeting that Chief Barger attended.
- Discussed Verizon internet connection.
