Thursday, Oct 6th, 2011 Minutes

Members Present: Jessica Hawkey and Steven Lust, also present Police Chief James Barger and President Nadine Walsten. Absent was Todd Klahn

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Motion: Jessica Hawkey / Steve Lust to approve Sep 1st , 2011 Safety Committee minutes.
Motion was carried

Motion: Jessica Hawkey / Steve Lust to postpone approval of March 3, 2011 Safety Committee minutes to next month. Motion was carried unanimously.

- 2011 Budget was reviewed and again appears overall expenses will be under budget. Install of new mobile radio base in squad car had an unanticipated problems with electrical, car will be out of service longer than anticipated. The cost of repair is unknown at this time. Chief will let us know at Oct 10th Broad meeting. PC in office needs to be replaced and network upgraded. Chief bought a filing cabinet, chair and desk from a resale shop for the office.
- 2012 Budget was discussed; very little has changed. Base radio from Baycom cost may go up.
- The department work schedule was reviewed. There are some open shifts in October.
- Chief Barger's monthly activity report was reviewed and discussed. Chief will be attending the IACP conference in Chicago leaving Oct.21 to Oct.26.
- The daily activity grids for calls-for-service, traffic, MOC, NOPV were discussed.
- Personnel Evaluation Review is still being worked on.
- Committee agreed to have Halloween "trick or treat" time at 4 pm to 7:30 pm on Halloween Day, same as last year.
- New Conceal Carry Law, as it relates to Village of Brooklyn facilities, was discussed. Chief will a sample ordinance from a local community at the next safety meeting. No recommendations have been made.
- Discussed possibility of bringing a Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) access to the Village for residents to update licenses and registrations. Committee agreed to recommend moving forward on this.

Motion: Jessica Hawkey / Steve Lust to recommend to Village Board in setting up a test polite program of WISDOT license renewal registrations with access to be at the Village Clark's Office from 10 am to 4 pm on Tuesday's. Motion was carried unanimously.

- Windows in office are now installed.
- Discussed new radio and mounting in squad car install and Office computer/wireless updates.
