- 2011 Budget was reviewed and again appears overall expenses will be under budget.
- 2012 Budget was discussed; very little has changed.
- The department work schedule was reviewed. There are some open shifts in November.
- Chief Barger's monthly activity report was reviewed and discussed. Chief and staff are continuing to work with residents on removing junk vehicles from their property. Staff evaluation status; Neubert & Quinn are being worked on. No reply yet regarding the WIDOT Service Center; discussed current status on Training Consortium.
- The daily activity grids for calls-for-service, traffic, MOC, NOPV were discussed. Call volume was down due to being without a squad car for about 10 Day.
- New Conceal Carry Law, as it relates to Village of Brooklyn facilities, was discussed. Chief will get a sample ordinance from a local community and bring to the next safety meeting. No recommendations have been made.
- Discussed Police radio purchasing. Committee felt that we may want to keep our purchasing down to a bare minimum at this time and look at purchasing a base unit at a later date.
