November 22, 2011

The Special Village Board meeting was called to order on Nov 12, 2011 at 6:34 pm by President Walsten. Trustees present were Todd Klahn, Steve Lust, Mark Bruner, Dorothy Frandy, Dean Van Den Eng, Jessica Hawkey. This meeting preceded the Joint Board Meeting with the Town of Rutland Board.

The item discussed was the name of the Village Clerk's office if it is moved to the Union Bank and Trust building, pending completion of the lease negotiations. The ED Committee has an order for wayfarer signs on hold until this matter is decided. A proposed name of the Village Clerk's office is the "Village Hall". The Clerks feel this is desirable because it is less confusing for people trying to find the Clerk's office and also, if the Village remains in the bank building over several years, and perhaps permanently, it will minimize future signage and address change problems. One question raised was is the name "Village Hall" antiquated and is there a more contemporary name for Village administration purposes. Motion was made and approved that the Clerks offices once located in UBT be named "Village Hall."
