- Chief Barger's monthly activity report discussed. December activities are up over last months' and over all Calls for Service for the year of 2011 are at 901 up compared to 753 in 2010.
- The daily activity grids for calls-for-service, traffic, MOC, NOPV were discussed. Committee would also like to see if a report can be obtained from 911 Service Center to see if there were any additional calls dispatched to the Village when there were no officers on duty.

- New Conceal Carry Law, as it relates to Village of Brooklyn facilities, was postponed.
- Status on WISDOT Grant and application for Village Talk Group was discussed. Still waiting on ok for grant.
