## **Safety committee**

### **Thursday, February 2, 2012 Minutes**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Members Present: Jessica Hawkey and Steven Lust, also present Chief Barger, President Nadine Walsten and Leif Spilde.

Members Absent: Todd Klahn

Motion: Jessica Hawkey / Steve Lust to approve January 5, 2012 Safety Committee minutes. Motion was carried

Presentation of Emergency Management Manual was given by Director Leif Spilde. Committee reviewed and discussed the manual along with Chief Barger and President Nadine Walsten.

Emergency Management Director also discussed with the committee about Village communications during a disaster and would like to see if he can setup a time to have a mock drill exercise of a real life disaster sometime this year. Leif left at 7:30 pm

Budget was reviewed, Barger stated that he was unable find funds of \$6,872.00 from 2011 budget to buy the two handheld radios that are needed comply with DaneCom communications system. The Committee will recommend to the Village Board to find another way of obtaining funds to cover the cost the radio equipment.

The department work schedule was discussed; there are a couple of open shifts that have not been filled. Chief Barger will work with personnel committee to find a way to cover the open shifts.

Chief's Report was reviewed. Barger gave an update on the current status of the Training Consortium; reviewed current activity, reviewed statistic forms for traffic citations, municipal ordinance citations, number of parking violations, incidents by day of week. January's activities of 93 calls are up over last year's 26 Calls for Service for month of January. Officer Sherven gave Chief Barger his letter of resignation, Barger has been doing a background check on a part-time hire for his replacement, should have it ready for the March meeting. Committee also reviewed the 2011 Use-of-Force Report.

New Conceal Carry Law, as it relates to Village of Brooklyn facilities, was discussed. Chief handed out a new Conceal Carry ordinance for the committee to review. The committee has recommended forwarding this to the Ordinance Committee for review and approval.

WISDOT Grant has been approved. The status on WISCOM Grant application for Village Talk Group was discussed; Chief Barger is waiting to hear back from them.
