PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MINUTES
July 9, 2009

Meeting was called to order at 5:33 p.m. Members present were Mark Bruner and Todd Klahn. Excused absence Helen McCord. Also present was Public Works Director Bob Anderson.

Bob gave an update on the WWTP. The new plant has been in operation since Tuesday, July 7, 2009. A leak was discovered in the scum tank. Rawson will inject expanding foam in the tank to seal the leak. No other problems have been reported. Madison Metro has begun removal of sludge from old oxidation ditch. Demolition of old plant has begun. Phones are working in the new control building. Internet is working on one computer, will be connected on the rest of them soon. Fax line is still not working.

The Hazard Mitigation Report was discussed. Bob presented 2 situations that need to be addressed. The first is implementation of the Village Emergency Response Plan. The second is the issue of storm water and flooding in the village. Action worksheets were prepared for both issues, and are included with these minutes.
