Committee discussed the second assistant position and determined that since the number of kids is manageable there would not be a need to hire a second assistant. Committee members were asked to donate crackers to the program as well as a sprinkler and a tie dye kit. Stacy Wolfe will ask the office to order a 1st aid kit for the program. The T-Shirts have been ordered and were sponsored by the Brooklyn Lions Club. They should arrive in a week.

Summer Music Series update was given by Janeen Podgorski. During the series Janeen Podgorski was approached by a Village Resident who was interested in playing the last date in August. The committee would have to approve going over budget to hire this band to play as we have already used the budget for the 2010 series. The committee voted to ask the resident to play the 2011 series because of budget limitations. Attendance has
