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Safety Committee Minutes Thursday, March 4, 2010 7:00 PM Village Hall

The meeting was called to order by Committee Chair Walsten at 7:10 pm with Todd Klahn, Helen McCord, and Chief Barger attending. The 12/4/10 minutes were approved (Klahn/Walsten) with McCord abstaining.

Officer Engelhart has been assuming his 24 hour/week schedule and all is going well. Chief Barger suggested that Officer Engelhart (as well as himself!) be sworn in at the next Village Board meeting. (Chief Barger will contact Officer Englehart to confirm attendance.)

Chief Barger reported the panel that is assessing the current records management system (New World) issue is expected to be reporting out their recommendations within the near future and he expects to have that information at next month's meeting.

The police coverage schedule is covered for March except 5 shifts remain open because of training. Chief Barger anticipates that the part time staff will pick up most of those shifts.

Attendance at the Green County Emergency Management classes was discussed. On 4/27 & 28, there is a Public Information Officer Training class which Walsten should attend as she would most likely be the PIO in case of a disaster. The Emergency Center Operations Course (6/20 & 21) was discussed and Walsten and most likely, Officer Engelhart should attend. Walsten will have the Village Clerk register her for both sessions. Chief Barger will address attendance with Officer Engelhart.

The reimbursement for the damaged children's play equipment secondary to a large party last summer at the Community Building was discussed. A motion to recommend to the Board a check for \$75 be paid to Mr. Forler was approved (Klahn/McCord).

Revision of Ordinance Chapter 22 (Nuisances) was postponed to next meeting (Klahn/McCord). Revision of Ordinance Chapter 21 (Large Assemblage) was postponed as well (Klahn/McCord).

The status of the DaneCom Radio System was discussed and Walsten stated that she had sent a letter to County Executive Falk with the Boards' decision to support the System on condition that final participation is contingent upon having more details re: costs, etc.

The 35 MPH sign on the north edge of the Village has been moved so it is now visible at a proper distance.

The Policy review schedule was discussed and the schedule is as follows: Use of Force (draft due at 4/10 meeting); Domestic Abuse tentatively due 5/10; and Open Records tentatively

due 6/10. We also discussed the need for the Village to create an electronics information/use policy as the use of cell phones with cameras, telecomputing (accessing office computer from home, for example), unauthorized internet sites, etc.

The department budget was reviewed and Chief Barger gave a report on the past months' current activity (see attached).

Meeting adjourned at 8:35 pm.
