Special Board Meeting

Minutes

The Special Village Board meeting was called to order by President Nadine Walsten on March 22, 2010, at 7:25 p.m. in the lower level of the Brooklyn Community Building. Trustees present: Helen McCord, Tim Belter and Mark Bruner. Others present: David Natzke, Steven Lust, Marty Pilger.

The resignation of Wendy Layton was read aloud by President Walsten. **Motion:** Bruner/McCord to accept resignation. Motion carried.

Walsten introduced David Natzke as a possible trustee appointment to replace Layton. Mr. Natzke is a former pastor for 30+ years in Illinois and has an extensive background working on the District Boards of Habitat for Humanity. He is very interested in giving to this community as a trustee and committee member. He moved to Brooklyn 8 months ago. **Motion:** Walsten/Bruner to approve appointment of David Natzke to finish out Wendy Layton's term. Motion carried. Oath of office was given by Walsten.

The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended to the Board to place a moratorium on the tower ordinance. Natzke offered to do research on wind turbine ordinance information. **Motion:** Bruner/Belter to approve recommendation from Planning and Zoning placing a 6 month moratorium on the tower ordinance. Carried.

**Motion:** Bruner/Belter to adjourn at 7:35pm. Carried.
