

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING

January 6, 2011

Chair Klahn called the meeting to order on January 6, 2011 at 7 p.m. with Trustee Lust and Natzke present. Chief Barger was also present.

Natzke moved, second Lust, carried to approve the minutes of Dec 2, 2010 as written.

2010 budget was reviewed with questions on squad outlay and wages being under budget.

Monthly coverage report was reviewed with some open shifts. Chief Barger presented new charts to show detailed hours the officers worked. Current activity log was reviewed.

Village Ordinance Chapter 32, Street, Traffic, Sidewalks was reviewed for an update. It is recommended to the Ordinance Committee to strike out 32.09 Jaywalking and replace with "Disturbance of the Peace with a Motor Vehicle (a)(b)(c)(d)(e)(f) from Municipal Code's sample ordinance and also add in "Temporary Parking Restrictions for street maintenance, special events, and weakness of the road bed due to deterioration or climatic conditions". Sections 10-1-30 Unlawful Removal of Parking Citations, 10-1-31 Operation of Motor Vehicles in Public Parking Lots (a)(b), and 10-1-32 Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles (a)(b)(c)(d)(e) from Municipal Code's sample ordinance are all recommended to be incorporated in the new ordinance.

Domestic Abuse Policy Directive #203 was recommended to send to the Board for approval per motion by Lust, second Natzke, carried.

Because of department staff changes with one officer leaving and possibly a second one leaving, Chief Barger will make some recommendations next month on **possible hiring**.

Lust moved, second Natzke, carried to adjourn at 8:41 p.m.
