Ordinance Committee **March, 21st 2011 Minutes**

Members Present: Mark Bruner and Steven Lust also present President Nadine Walsten. Absence was David Natzke

Meeting was called to order at 6:32pm.

Motion: Mark Bruner/Steven Lust to approve Feb 21st, 2011 Ordinance Committee meeting minutes. *Motion was carried unanimously*

Chapter 23 Offenses against the Public Peace, Order Curfew and Other Matters was reviewed by the committee, along with recommendations from Walsten. With to the following changes to Sec 23.13 to strike first paragraph (A) and change (B) to (A) and strike “shall” in the last sentence of paragraph (B). Changes to Sec 23.16 Loitering. Strike “~~or prowl~~” in the first sentence of the paragraph. Sec.23.18. (A) change ~~school board~~ to school district, changes to (C) change ~~forfeit~~ to **forfeiture** and strike “~~provided that any person smoking, as defined by Wis. Stat. 101.123(1)(h), in an educational facility, as defined by Wis. Stat. 101.123(1)(a), shall forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$500~~” and in (D) strike “~~to the Brooklyn Municipal Court~~” . Strike ~~Sec. 23.19. Purchase, possession, sale or gift of tobacco products~~ ~~Offenses against the peace and good order.~~ and ~~Sec. 23.20. Penalties.~~

Motion: Mark Bruner/Steven Lust to approve Chapter 23 with changes. *Motion was carried unanimously*

The Committee and President Nadine Walsten had discussed Chapter 49 Trees and made changes to 49.01 (3) (A) to read as “ -The Village board may designate a citizen to perform the duties of Forester under Chapter 27, Wis. Stats., and may authorize such Forester to perform the duties and exercise the powers imposed **by** the Village Board by this chapter. ~~It~~ **Village board** may also appoint the Director of Public Works (**hear in after referred to as the Forester**) to perform the duties of Village Forester.

Motion: Mark Bruner/Steven Lust to approve Chapter 49 with changes. *Motion was carried unanimously*

Walsten had given out a completed updated copy of Chapter 2 Administration. The Committee had reviewed and discussed some changes and more update that need to be done. Walsten will make the changes and the update to Chapter 2 and she will have them ready be for the next Ordinance Committee meeting.

The Committee and President Nadine Walsten had discussed the Recodification of our ordinances we are close to getting all the work done. Chapter 20 will be put on next month's agenda so that we can include a ordinance for Assemblage of Large Number of People.
