Recreation Committee Minutes
Tuesday, May 22, 2012

Jill Van Den Eng called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm. Jill Van Den Eng, Tari Lust, Ginger Valiska, Dorothy Frandy, Brit Springer, Stacy Wolfe and Stacey Hardy were in attendance.

Dime a Dip update – After accounting for expenses, 2012 Dime a Dip ticket sales, donations and silent auction items brought in \$541.97 for future recreation committee projects and park equipment.

Rec Run Update – Public Works can provide 50+ traffic cones and paint for marking the route. They also have several 24x24 signs to warn drivers at crosswalks. Hardy suggested having more than one sign to warn drivers at intersections, as it is easy to miss a single sign.

Four people are registered for the 5k fun run/walk so far, but others have expressed an interest in participating. Turnout could be low the first year, but will build with time.

Donations for t-shirts may exceed the need. Hardy is telling sponsors that if we don't use the money on t-shirts this year, we will carry the donation dollars over to purchase more t-shirts in 2013.

Frandy suggested the committee contact the Oregon Observer newspaper and Sharon George, local historian, for coverage of the event and to advertise the rec run.

The committee convened to Closed Session Pursuant to Wis. Stats 19.85 (1)(c) to discuss applicants and make hiring decisions for Summer Youth Recreation director and assistant positions.

Frandy made a motion to adjourn. Wolfe seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:48 pm.
