Recreation Committee Minutes
Thursday, September 6, 7 pm
Brooklyn Community Building

Jill Van Den Eng called the meeting to order at 7:06 pm. Jill Van Den Eng, Stacey Hardy, Brit Springer, Tari Lust, and Dorothy Frandy were in attendance. Also attending was Tracie Meyer.

Committee members introduced themselves to potential new member, Tracie Meyer.

Frandy made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 15 meeting. Hardy seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.

The proposed 2013 budget was reviewed. Each line item was visited. The committee trimmed the budget by more than 10 percent and added a new fundraiser (Rec Run) in 2012. The committee would like to add another new program (Craft Show) in 2013.

Hardy made a motion to make no changes to the budget for 2013. Lust seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Movie selections were reviewed for Family Movie Night starting this October. The committee chose the following movies and dates: October 6 –The Lorax, November 3 – Pirates, Band of Misfits, December 1 – Brave.

Van Den Eng has the movie banner that is displayed near the Mobil station. She suggested the committee purchase two or three more vinyl banner signs advertising the free family movie nights at the other entrances to the village.

Lust suggested similar signs be made to advertise upcoming fitness classes. The only sign for fitness classes is the sandwich board sign that is placed in front of the building the week of classes. There are no signs prompting residents to register for classes.

Frandy made a motion to allow the purchase of suggested banners and signs. Springer seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Get Fit fitness classes will begin on Thursday, October 4 and run for five weeks. Registration information is at the village clerk's office, but has not yet been posted on the

website. It should have been posted in August to give participants more time to access the registration forms.

Winter Fest was not discussed because there was not enough snow last year.

The website was discussed. Springer proposed the committee build and control a website for activities and provide links to be displayed on the village website. Frandy suggested the committee get board approval to build a website. Van Den Eng will ask it be put on the Village Board agenda.

Meyer expressed an interest in joining the committee to help plan activities. She likes to plan things and the committee needs many hands to make all the programs it offers happen.

Springer made a motion to add Tracie Meyer to the Recreation Committee. Lust seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.

New ideas. Hardy suggested having volleyball tournaments during the Fire/EMS Labor Day Celebration. She will talk to Fire/EMS about it to see if they are interested in adding this attraction to the event.

Hardy made a motion to adjourn at 8:14 pm. Frandy seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.
