Recreation Committee Minutes
Wednesday, January 3, 2013 – 6:30 pm
Brooklyn Community Building

Jill Van Den Eng called the meeting to order at 6:37 pm. Jill Van Den Eng, Stacy Wolfe, Tari Lust, Tracie Meyer, Stacey Hardy and Dorothy Frandy were in attendance. Ginger Valiska and Brit Springer were absent.

Lust made a motion to approve the minutes from the December meeting. Frandy seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.

The committee discussed selling beer at an Antique Tractor Pull event planned for June 22. It would be a good fundraising activity for the committee. Concerns were timing of the event and comfort level with selling beer. Committee voted four to three to pass on this opportunity, but would consider it next year if the event returns. The committee will also discuss selling beer during the July 4th Celebration.

Movie night attendance was up in the fall, with people asking for more. Movies were shown in February and March in past years. The committee chose to show Ice Age 4 on February 2. If the movie is well attended and committee members are available to work, the event will continue into March.

Concession sales were reviewed. The committee will raise the price for candy to better cover supply costs.

Frandy updated the committee on July 4 preparations. Dan Dean expressed interest in directing the fireworks display again this year. The committee will use the same contract. Entertainment was discussed. The dj from last year is available. The bounce house is not. Meyer suggested adding more children's games.

Frandy is preparing a letter soliciting donations from local businesses. Wolfe suggested the committee follow up with a phone call or visit.

The second annual Rec Run is planned for June 8, 2013. The fun run/walk will take place earlier in the morning, starting at 8:15 or 8:30. Hardy is looking for timing equipment, such as a clock so participants can see their time as they cross the finish line. Hardy is also interested in starting a running group to train for the fun run/walk. This group would start meeting when the snow melts.

Monetary and in kind donations will be solicited for the Rec Run from fitness clubs and local businesses. Donators will be displayed on participant t-shirts and/or other products.

Get Fit is sponsoring a Zumbathon to raise money and awareness for ALS. The event is planned for January 19 from 10-11:30 am. This event had a good turnout last year and will be a precursor to the return of Get Fit Zumba classes in February.

Zumba classes return to the Brooklyn Community Building on Thursday nights at 6:30, starting on February 7. Registration is now available on the website. Cost is \$25 for five weeks. Lust compiled a list of past participants and will distribute to committee members to contact and remind them of the upcoming classes.

The Craft Show was discussed, with past paperwork looked at to determine how many booths and pricing. A sub committee is being formed to nail down the details for this event.

Wolfe made a motion to adjourn at 8:07 pm. Frandy seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.
