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Safety committee **Thursday, June 4, 2013 Minutes**

Meeting was called to order at 7:26 pm.

Members Present: Todd Klahn, Sue McCallum and Steven Lust, also present Chief Barger,

Motion: Todd Klahn / Sue McCallum to appoint Steven Lust as chair of Safety Committee. Motion was carried

Budget was not reviewed

The department work schedule was discussed; Chief Barger stated that most of the open shifts in May he was able to fill, Reviewed June's tentative work schedule.

Chief's Report was reviewed; applied for grant money for a new bullet resistant vest replacement, the rental of the community building recently again created a problem with loud noise from the event that was taking place, the staff was unable to operate. The department would like to see that the Village takes some action on this matter going forward to help resolve this issue. P.D participated in "click it or Ticket" through WISDOT, Chief has been in contact with Public Works Director Langer on attempt to get the speed limit on 92 east of the Village lowered. Reviewed current activity, statistic forms for traffic citations, municipal ordinance citations, numbers of parking violations, incidents by day of week was done. May's activities of 90 calls are up over last year's 80 Calls for Service for the month.

Discussed the next step in the hiring process for part-time Police Officer, interviews of applicants have been completed. Still working on background checks

Status of Squad car change-over is now in full service.

Working on a Time system policy #114 not ready, will need to review it with the Dane County Public Safety Communications Department.

Discussed developing procedures regarding what safety related issues/matter will be processed through the Safety Committee before Village Board Approval. Committee reviewed the policy on liquor license and public event permits and will continue to work on this policy for next month's meeting and will seek additional input from community groups and committees in the creation of this policy that can promote the Village's events and look out for the safety and well being of all those involved .
