Recreation Committee Agenda
Thursday, January 2, 2014 6:30 pm
Brooklyn Community Building

Meeting called to order at 6:35pm. Stacey Hardy (chair). Brit Springer, Dorothy Frandy, Tari Lust, Sheri Maass were in attendance. Karley Forstrom, Summer Harnack and Erika Klahn were also in attendance - they are interested in joining the Recreation Committee - all reside within the Oregon School District.

Springer made a motion to approve the minutes from December 19, 2014. Frandy seconded - all voted Aye - motion passed.

Holiday House Decorating contest winners all have received their checks and certificates. All winners will be put on the website along with a photo of the house.

Budget was not reviewed at this time - it was tabled until the next meeting.

Get Fit Yoga Classes start on January 13th - classes will be held on Monday nights at 6:30pm, Thursday nights at 6:30pm and Saturday mornings at 9:00am. Flyers have been posted - more will be going up this week. Registration forms are available online and Hardy will have some printed. Punch cards are in the making - will be ready for Monday nights class. We will be using a punch card system for Get Fit classes - 10 punch is \$45, 6 punch is \$30 and monthly unlimited is \$35. Children 13 and under are free with a paying adult. Family discount was discussed as was a student discount (ages 14-17). Family discount would be 2 or more using the 10 punch card - the cost would be \$40. Student discount is 50% off any punch card. Hardy will contact the High School and see if any students need to get community service hours - if we can get students to help us out we may be able to offer childcare. Childcare will be discussed at the next meeting.

We have two more movie nights schedule - February 1st and March 1st - Springer and Hardy will be working. Planning to have a double feature on March 1st - discuss further at next meeting. Hardy also suggested possibly extending the Movie Night out a few months - depending on attendance of the next two nights.

Dime A Dip is approaching - Hardy will be getting the call list together within the next few months. The next Dime A Dip will be on May 1st, 2014.

Rec Run has a tentative date of June 14th, 2014 - Hardy is going to check and see what other runs are around the area that day. Hardy will be working on the Registration and Sponsorship forms. Springer will be working on creating the t-shirt and flyers. Maass may have some possible sponsors ☺.

Summer Youth Recreation was discussed - this is a 6 week program for children ages 6-12. Springer will be contacting last years Lead to see if she is still interested in returning. Assistant

Lead Ms. Proto will not be returning this year ☹ - as she will be in Italy ☺. We will have to post the open position/positions by April. Springer has some ideas for a new t-shirt design – Black logo on a white shirt so the kids could possibly tie-dye them as a group project. Hardy made a motion to increase the registration fee to \$25 for the 1st kid and then \$10 for each additional. Frandy Seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.

4th of July celebration entertainment has been booked - Distant Cuzins out of Oregon. Frandy is working with Dan Dean to see if July 5th would work for a rain date (if needed). We will be working on donation letters – those said letters should go out in March/April. Frandy is going to form a sub-committee to work on 4th of July events.

Hardy suggested checking into running a Farmers Market – to be discussed further in February. Harnack asked about a Nerf War/Competition – said her son suggested it. The committee will check into running some sort of event at the community building. Springer suggested having a store front on Café Press – will discuss further at next meeting. Hardy suggested checking into light pole flags with Rec Committee Logos – each flag would have a sponsor that would pay a set amount each year – discuss further at next meeting.

Hardy made a motion to nominate Karley Forstrom, Ericka Klahn and Summer Harnack as members of the Recreation Committee. Maass seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed.

Maass made a motion to adjourn the meeting – Hardy seconded – all voted Aye. Meeting adjourned at 8:15pm.
