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Recreation Committee Minutes
Thursday, December 4, 2014 @ 7:30 pm

Meeting was called to order at 7:41pm. Stacey Hardy (Chair), Brit Springer, Hope Mikkelson, Jessica Klahn and Emmi Schreiner were in attendance. Dorothy Frandy, Erika Klahn and Sheri Maass were absent.

Shreiner made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 6th meeting. Klahn seconded. All voted Aye. Motion passed.

Get Fit classes will be changing in January – Hardy has spoken with all the instructors and everything is a go. Monday nights at 6:30pm will be Yoga Bliss with Kelly Perna (of Side Pony Yogi) - Yoga will be a little different with the fact that the 1st Monday of the month will be Yin, 2nd Monday will be Flow, 3rd Monday will be Yin/Flow, 4th Monday will be a Workshop and if there is a 5th Monday it will be teachers choice. Wednesday nights at 6:30pm will be Zumba with Nicole P. (classes will be 6 weeks on and then 1 week off). Thursday nights at 6:30pm will be Pound with Katie M.. Saturday mornings at 9:00am will be alternating Yoga Body Bootcamp™ on the 2nd & 4th Saturday (with Kelly P.) and Barre Class on the 1st & 3rd Saturday (with Cheryl L.). Klahn suggested having a night that has 2 classes offered – this is something that we will revisit in the spring. Springer suggested that we put the instructors Bio on the website – Hardy will contact instructors to get the bio information.

Hardy spoke with instructor Katie Monk about a Pre-Ballet class for kids ages 4-7. Classes would be on Thursday night at 5:45pm. Also spoke about having an adult Tap class that Monk would also instruct – we will revisit that in the spring.

Craft Show had 29 crafter/vendors (with on having a double booth). Attendance was down a little from last year. We collected 2 totes of food for the Brooklyn/Oregon Food Pantry – we also collected \$267 from the donation jar. No real complaints – everything seemed to run pretty smooth. There was only one thing that put a damper on the event – there is not a lot of parking – and one person was going to be ticketed if he didn't move his vehicle (he was only parked for a few minutes unloading items for the Methodist Church Ladies group). Springer made a motion to have the next Craft Show on November 14th, 2015. Schreiner seconded. All voted Aye. Motion passed.

The 3rd movie night which is a double feature is this Saturday – doors will open at 4:30pm – with the first movie starting at 5:00 – Second movie will start at 7:00. Springer and

Hardy will work the event – Mikkelson will help out at the 2nd movie. Hardy will check supplies and get anything that is needed. January and February movies have been picked. We will pick March, April and May movies at the January or February meeting.

Holiday House decorating is going on now – deadline is December 15th. There are 3 categories this year – with the winner in each category receiving \$75. The categories are Themed, Griswald and Classical. We will have a meeting on December 18th at 7:30pm to choose the winners for this years event.

Hardy brought up the idea of having a Health Fair – wanted to do it in early Spring – but, wouldn't have enough time to get everything done. The group decided to have the Health Fair on September 19th, 2015. We will want to get a dentist, chiropractor, nutritionist and doctor - possibly a massage therapist, aroma therapy person. Check and see if Dean Clinic/UW Health/GHC would like to co-sponsor the event. Klahn suggested having a wii (gaming device) available to show that you can exercise while using the device. We will discuss the Health Fair more at the January meeting.

Schreiner made a motion to adjourn. Klahn seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 9:20pm.
