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Recreation Committee Minutes
Thursday, April 2, 2015 @ 7:30 pm
Brooklyn Community Building

Meeting was called to order at 7:33pm. Stacey Hardy (chair), Brit Springer, Erika Klahn, Jessica Klahn, Emmi Schreiner & Hope Mikkelson were in attendance. Dorothy Frandy (trustee) was absent.

Springer made a motion to approve the minutes from March 5, 2015 meeting. Schreiner seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed. Mikkelson abstained.

Budget was tabled until next meeting.

Get Fit program is still doing good - but, the numbers are starting to drop – we have added an incentive program for the month of April. The person who attends the most classes in the month of April will receive a prize (can not be a committee member). Springer will get a poster/flyer made and then post it on Facebook – we will then have a poster posted at the Get Fit classes. Hardy/Springer will get the prize ordered. We have gotten some feedback on a couple of the classes (but, we need more) - we are going to make feedback/comment cards and see what positive feedback we can get about our classes and see what we need to work on. We need to get more posted on Facebook about the Pound class and Yoga Body Bootcamp™ - if people see what the class is maybe they will be more likely to attend. We have also been asked about an adult Pre-Ballet class/Tap Class. Mikkelson is going to start a running group at the end of April/beginning of May. She is thinking that the group will meet on Sunday afternoons (3:00pm) – and split into 2 groups (beginner/advanced). The groups will run the route of the Rec Run in hopes that the running group participants will then register for the Rec Run on June 13th.

Movie Nights having been going good – we only have two nights left. Springer and Mikkelson will be working the event on April 4th. Hardy will be sure there is enough concessions for the event. We will have our last movie night (until fall) on May 2nd – Hardy/Schreiner/Mikkelson will work that event.

The Spring session of Pre-Ballet starts next Thursday, April 9th. So far we have 2 kids registered – with another confirmed (just haven't received the paperwork yet). Hardy will check and see if a previous participant is going to be joining.

Dime A Dip is approaching fast. Hardy/Springer will work on postcards to go out to village residents. Hardy will have call lists for all committee members by April 15th. Calls to village residents will start April 20th. Dime A Dip will be May 7th – starting at 4:30pm and at approx. 6:30pm. Rec committee will meet on May 6th at 6:30pm for set up and monthly meeting.

Rec Run will be held on June 13th. New this year will be a 1k for the kids – 1k will start at 7:30am. 5k Run will start at 8:00am and the walk to follow at 8:05am. Hardy will contact Kelly Perna about having a Yoga class at 7:30am for all participants. We have received two sponsorship forms. Springer will get flyer ready for distribution.

Summer Rec – Neither the lead or the assistant will be returning this year. Springer will post positions on the government site, recreation site, UW and MATC sites (and any other site she finds). We have a candidate for the Coordinator/Assistant Coordinator position – she was a previous coordinator. Springer asked for someone to be a back up for her – Mikkelson and Hardy will take that responsibility (with Mikkelson being first back up and then Hardy if needed). Springer will set up a meeting with Mikkelson, Schreiner and Hardy

to go over the Summer Rec program duties/handbooks. Summer Rec start date is June 29th – 6 week program that runs Monday through Thursday from 1:00 until 4:00.

4th of July event planning is underway – Frandy had a sub-committee meeting on Saturday, March 14th at 10:30am. Sponsorship letter was discussed at the sub-committee meeting – Hardy will get the letter sent out. We need to plan another sub-committee meeting for April.

Healthy Living Expo (September 19th) – Schreiner & Hardy attend the Healthy Living Expo in Middleton last month and they got some good ideas from it. Hardy will have a sub-committee meeting on April 21st at 6:30pm – with E. Klahn, J. Klahn, Schreiner and Springer.

Craft Fair is November 14th – We currently have 1 vendor/crafters (paid) and 3 more sending in the forms/money – these are the vendor/crafters from last year. We will open up registrations to the general public within the next few weeks.

Hardy talked about the idea of having workshops – ie. Adobe, Canvas/Pain Night, Craft, Kid Craft, etc. Hardy asked all member to think about what kind of workshops we could offer and bring it to the next meeting.

E.Klahn made a motion to adjourn the meeting. J. Klahn seconded. All voted Aye. Motion passed.
