Recreation Committee Minutes
Thursday, November 5, 2015 @ 6:30 pm

Meeting was called to order at 6:34. Stacey Hardy (Chair), Emmi Schreiner, Pat Hawkey, Erica Klahn, Jessica Thompson, Dorothy Frandy were present. Hope Mikkelson was absent. Sue McCallum was also present.

Frandy moved, Shreiner seconded motion to approve minutes from October 8, 2015. Motion carried. Hawkey abstained.

Sue McCallum attended the recreation committee to discuss an alternative exit from Legion Park. There were several comments about how this would work and what it would require.

Klahn, Hardy and Frandy will meet on Friday and set up for the event (they will tape the crafter/vendor booth areas and get the table and chairs out). We discussed the fact that our vendor/crafter numbers are down this year – we hope to get applications to possible new vendors earlier in the year (as crafters/vendors seem to book up fast). Frandy/Hardy will open the building on Saturday

morning – building should be open by about 6:45am. Crafter/Vendors can start setting up at 7:00am.

Healthy Living Expo is approaching. It will be held on January 16th from 9:00am - 1:00pm. We have approximately 10 booths booked – with the hopes of getting some more. Hardy will work on demonstration schedule and speakers. We will discuss more at the next meeting.

Dance Classes were discussed, ballet and maybe classes for older people.
