Recreation Committee Minutes
Thursday, July 7, 2016 @ 6:30 pm
Brooklyn Community Building

Meeting was called to order at 6:33pm. Stacey Hardy (Chair), Bruce Crubaugh (Trustee), Erika Klahn, Jessica Thompson & Rex Tilley were in attendance. Hope Mikkelson and Emmi Schriener were absent.

Hardy made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 2nd meeting. Klahn Seconded. All voted Aye. Motion passed.

Rec Run attendance was very low this year – it has been dwindling in attendance since the second year. We have the sponsorship – we just do not have the participants. We may have to think about canceling this event in the future – we will discuss at an upcoming meeting.

Get Fit participation numbers are still low. Nicole (Zumba Instructor) – needs a week off. There will be no Zumba classes on July 13th (regularly schedule off) and July 20th – class will resume July 27th. We will reevaluate at the next meeting.

Summer Youth Rec is underway – session started on June 27th and will go through August 4th (1-4pm). We have 31 kids signed up – with not all of them coming every day. We have 3 scheduled field trips (Zoo, Madison Children's Museum and Troll Beach/Mandt Park). **Hardy made a motion to change Beth Klahn's hours from 20 to 24 hours per week starting June 27th. Crubaugh seconded. All voted Aye. Motion passed.**

Labor Day Celebration (September 3rd & 4th) – we will be doing the Kiddie Tractor Pull (UB&T will be helping us with this event). This year we will run the event by child's weight not age – sign up/registration will start at Noon both days with the actual pulls starting at 1:00pm. Hardy will check into a banner for the event.

Craft Fair will be held on September 3rd from 9:00am – 3:00pm. We currently have 6 confirmed crafters and 5 vendors that are registered. Hardy will contact the tentative registrations to see if they will be joining or not. We will get another flier out to recruit more crafters/vendors.

We talked about doing another 5k/1k event in October – the Haunted Hustle. The talk didn't really go anywhere and we will probably wait until next year to do this event (if we decide to do it). We will discuss again at the next meeting and make a final decision.

Healthy Living Expo will be held in Oregon with a tentative date of January 14th – as the big wellness expo at the Monona Terrace will be held on January 20-21, 2017. This event is co-sponsored with the Oregon Area Wellness Coalition. Hardy will be in contact with them to see what we should work on for the event.

Hardy made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Thompson seconded. All voted aye. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:33pm.
